

Cyber Cypher research, Consent information

You are participating in the “Cyber Cypher” research study, which aims to preserve and study the artistry of hip hop, and develop the next generation of technology for hip hop producers and consumers.

- **Voluntary consent**
 - Participation in research is always voluntary; you may revoke your consent (and leave) at any time.
- **Session plan**
 - The session should take two to three hours, but you may leave at any time.
 - During the session, we will simply ask you to perform as you normally would in a cypher or recording session, while we record (audio/video).
 - To hear the beats, you will wear in-ear headphones throughout.
- **Ethics**
 - Georgia Tech has a review board to oversee research like this, to make sure that it is done ethically and to protect *your* rights.
 - * This research has been reviewed and deemed minimal risk research.
 - The risks of participating are no greater than your normal activities as an MC.
- **Compensation & Benefits**
 - For participating today, you will be compensated with a \$100 gift card of your choosing.
 - We will also gift you an additional \$50 if you help us with “annotating” your recordings later, online.
 - For you gift card(s), you may choose to receive either a physical \$100 prepaid VISA card or, via email, \$100 worth of gift credit at a variety of online retailers.
 - Note that U.S. Tax Law may require you pay taxes on this income.
- **Confidentially**
 - We are required by law to protect your private information and keep it confidential.
 - If you would like to be attributed when we share these recordings, please let me know now or at anytime in the future. Otherwise, we will keep your contribution anonymous—you name will never be attached to the data.
 - If you wish to be contacted for the follow up “annotation” work, please provide me your contact information. Your contact information will be stored on secure GT servers only until the follow-up research is complete, after which it will be deleted. We will not contact you for any reason other than follow-up research.
 - Your information recorded at the time you booked this recording session will be deleted after today’s session.
